## CCASA

Offender as stranger	24%
Victims 18-25 at onset of abuse	42%

	Minimum	Maximum	Median in 90% of cases
Level I Sexual assault	Fine, probation, house arrest, community service No minimum jail time	10 years	2 years or less
Level II Sexual assault with a weapon	If a gun: 4 years Without a gun: no minimum jail time	14 years	7 years or less
Level III Aggravated sexual assault	4 years minimum jail time	25 years to life	15 years or less
